The main objective of the competition was to encourage creativity, ability to think quickly, write persuasively and present well-connected ideas through essay writing.



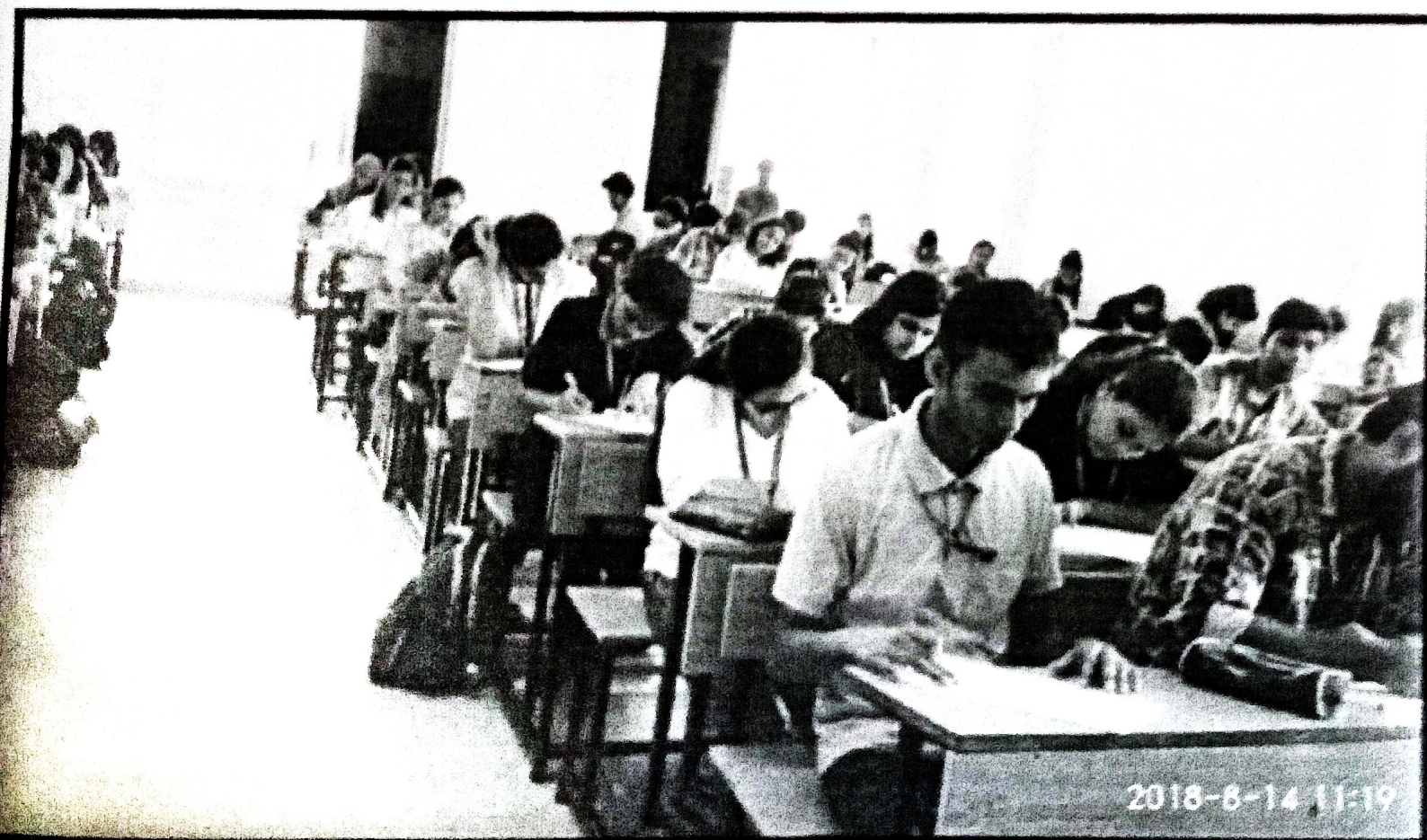
