Evolution of banking services in India

- In ancient India, loan deed forms called **rasapatra** or **mudikkhya** were in use.
- Witnessed by a person of respectable means and endorsed by a loan-deed writer.
- During **Buddhist** period, loan deeds were called as **rasapanna**
- In the **Mauryan** period, an instrument called '**Adasha**' was in use, which was an order on a banker desiring him to pay the money of the note to a third person, which is similar to Cheque.
- Numerous references to **Letters of Credit, Promissory Notes**, etc.
