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28th February, 2023, a workshop on "Organ Donation Awareness Campaign" was organized by resource person Ms. Urbi Pal. 78 students participated in this session.











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


EDUCATIONAL VISIT FOR BBI 2022-23

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






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







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
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WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL

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
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

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
















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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) COMMITTEE 2022-23


IQAC and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Committee of Chandrabhan Sharma College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Powai organized guest lecture on Wednesday, 21th September, 2022. The topics covered were 'Introduction and History of IPR' by Ms. Poorva Sharma and 'Types of IP with examples' by Adv. Gunjan Deshpande. Both the resource persons are Research Assistant at the Department for Promotion of Industries and Internal Trade (DPIIT)- IPR Chair under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Maharashtra National Law University, Mumbai. The aim of the guest lecture was to create awareness about intellectual property laws among the students. This will help them to know the importance of intellectual property and different types of works protected by the IP laws in India.

The programme started with welcome speech of Ms. Saakshi. Mr. Anurag and Mr. Shivam introduced our guests.

The hon'ble guest speaker Ms. Poorva Sharma started the discussion on the topic explaining the brief history and fundamentals of the intellectual property law. The other hon'ble guest speaker Adv. Gunjan Deshpande provided additional facets and nuances on the various types of IP and the different types of works protected by the intellectual property law.

Around 60 students participated in this lecture. This session introduced the student to the basics of Intellectual Property Rights, Copy Right Laws Trade Marks and Issues related to Patents. 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


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N-List E-Resources: User Awareness Programme

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
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HEALTH AND COUNSELING CELL

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
