Financial Freedom


Date: 24th July, 2021


Fundamentals Of IPR


Date: 3rd September, 2021

Commercial Banking Certificate Program




Description:










NET / SET Guidance For Paper-I




Mock Interview






Alumni Meet




Webinar On Ipr & Its Role In Research


Certificate Program – Digital Marketing


Meme Masti


Youth Employability Program




Webinar- Teaching Through Case Study & Experiential learning.




Product Photography Competition- "Uniquely Captured"


World Photography Day- Food Photography




