

- Contribution to Organizational Goals: 57.14% of employers rate students' contribution as "Good," with 4.76% rating it "Excellent," while 23.80% consider it "Average."
- Technical Knowledge, Skill, Leadership, and Innovativeness: 42.85% rate these skills as "Good," and 38.09% as "Very Good," with few rating them "Excellent."
- Creativity: 23.80% rate creativity as "Excellent," 33.33% as "Very Good," and 38.09% as "Good."
- **Building Relationships:** 57.14% rate students' relationship-building skills as "Very Good," and 38.09% as "Good."
- Involvement in Social Activities: 42.85% rate involvement as "Excellent," and 42.85% as "Very Good."
- Ability and Motivation for Social Activity: 38.09% rate it as "Very Good," 23.80% as "Good," and 14.28% as "Average."
- **Obligation to Work Beyond Schedule:** 42.85% rate students' willingness as "Very Good," 19.04% as "Excellent," with 28.57% rating it "Good" and 9.52% as "Average."
- Overall Performance: 28.57% rate students' performance as "Excellent," 33.33% as "Good," and 19.04% as "Average."



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

- Syllabus Suitability: 82.76% agree, 17.24% strongly agree that the syllabus is suitable for the course.
- Need-based Syllabus: 72.41% agree, 17.24% neutral, 10.34% strongly agree.
- Aims and Objectives: 86.21% strongly agree, 13.79% agree that they are clear.
- Course Content and Reference Materials: 68.97% agree, 20.69% strongly agree, 6.90% neutral, 3.45% disagree.
- Balance of Theory and Practical: 62.07% agree, 20.69% disagree, indicating a need for improvement.
- **Knowledge and Perspective Enhancement**: 79.31% agree, 20.69% strongly agree that the course enhances knowledge.
- Optional Papers: 72.41% agree, 27.59% strongly agree that there are sufficient options.
- Relevance of Reference Materials: 68.97% agree, 27.59% strongly agree, 3.45% neutral.
- Relevance to Career Opportunities: 68.97% agree, 13.79% neutral, 17.24% disagree.
- **Industrial Requirements**: 34.48% agree, 31.03% strongly disagree, indicating a gap in meeting industry needs.



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
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

- **Syllabus Relevance:** 77.32% of alumni find the syllabus relevant to their professional life, indicating strong alignment with career needs.
- **Value-Based Learning**: 83.50% believe the syllabus provided valuable skills, knowledge, and critical thinking, reflecting positive learning outcomes.
- Coverage of Contemporary Issues: 73.20% agree the syllabus covers global issues, though 21.65% disagree, suggesting room for improvement.
- **Knowledge and Skills Acquisition**: 76.29% feel the syllabus meets expectations in knowledge and practical application, with 17.53% expressing concerns.
- **Industry-Academia Bridge:** 79.39% rate academic initiatives bridging industry and academia positively, though 12.37% remain neutral.
- Evaluation Methods: 81.45% are satisfied with evaluation methods, with only 10.31% dissatisfied.
- **Graduate Attributes**: 78.36% agree the syllabus promotes key attributes like gender sensitization and employability, though 10.31% disagree.
- **Library Resources:** 82.48% are satisfied with library resources, though 7.21% have concerns about availability.
- **Internet Services and Library Environment**: 76.29% rate internet services and the library environment positively, with some feedback on seating and lighting.
- Access to Library and Sports Facilities: 79.39% feel they have adequate access to the library, and 77.32% value sports opportunities, though 12.63% report limited access to sports equipment.
- College Events and Cleanliness: 74.89% are satisfied with cleanliness and events, though some suggest improvements in event organization.
- Career Guidance and Job Fairs: 75.25% appreciate the college's career guidance and job fairs, with some alumni (12.37%) being neutral or dissatisfied.



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

- Curriculum Understandability: 82.76% of students find the curriculum easy to understand, indicating clear course content.
- **Semester Pattern Convenience:** 77.59% of students feel the semester pattern is convenient, but 13.8% find it challenging.
- **Curriculum Coverage:** 82.18% of students believe the curriculum is covered properly in each semester, with a small minority dissenting.
- Advanced Knowledge: 82.76% feel the curriculum provides advanced knowledge, though 10.35% think it lacks depth.
- **Practical Knowledge:** 81.61% believe the curriculum offers opportunities for practical learning, while 10.92% disagree.
- **Job Opportunities:** 56.89% find the syllabus useful for job opportunities, but 36.21% feel it does not align with industry needs.

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Smt. Durgadevi Sharma Charitable Trust's

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- Teaching Methodology: 86.21% of students find the teaching methodology easy to understand, with minor dissatisfaction.
- Exam Process Satisfaction: 81.61% of students are satisfied with the exam process, while 13.22% are dissatisfied.
- Learning Values in Lectures: 82.76% appreciate the learning values emphasized in lectures, with some minor disagreement.
- Availability of Reading Materials: 78.74% find sufficient access to reading materials, though 14.37% disagree.
- Syllabus Completion: 83.91% believe faculties complete the syllabus on time, with a small percentage voicing concerns.

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Feedback Report 2023-24

1. Employer Feedback:

- Employers rate students positively, with 57.14% viewing their contributions as "Good." Most employers consider their technical knowledge, leadership, and creativity as "Good" (42.85%) or "Very Good" (38.09%).
- Relationship-building skills are rated "Very Good" by 57.14%, and 42.85% rate students' social involvement as "Excellent." However, 19.04% find performance "Average," indicating areas for improvement.

2. Teacher Feedback:

- Teachers are generally satisfied with the syllabus (82.76%), agreeing it meets students' needs and objectives (86.21%).
- However, 20.69% feel the balance of theory and practice needs improvement, and 31.03% disagree that the syllabus aligns with industry needs, though 68.97% find reference materials relevant.

3. Alumni Feedback:

- Alumni find the syllabus relevant to their careers (77.32%) and value-based learning beneficial (83.50%).
- o Most (79.39%) believe academic initiatives bridge the gap between industry and academia.
- However, 21.65% feel contemporary issues coverage could improve, and only 34.48% believe the syllabus meets industry requirements.

4. Student Feedback:

- Students are satisfied with curriculum understandability (82.76%) and teaching methods (86.21%).
 While 81.61% find the curriculum provides practical knowledge, 36.21% express concerns about its job alignment.
- The exam process and syllabus completion are well-received, but 14.37% are dissatisfied with reading material availability.

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Action Taken Report 2023-24

- 19.04% of the employers addressed the performance rating as Average:
 - Hence suggested to strengthen industry partnerships for internship and mentorships also introducing skills development workshops.
- o 58.62% teachers disagreed that the syllabus was not designed as per industrial requirement.
 - Hence the IQAC committee suggested to bridge the gap by conducting courses like "Advanced Program on Java Full Stack Development Using Angular" in collaboration with Anudip Foundation.
- 9.28% of the alumni agreed that the syllabus does not meet the expectation in terms of knowledge acquisition, skills upgradation and practical orientation to real life situations.
 - Organizing guest lectures on the current industry trends was suggested by the IQAC committee.
 - Also strengthening alumni collaboration for better alignment with industry needs.
- 36.21% of the students were concerned over job alignment:
 - Enhancing career services with more job opportunities and refining curriculum to match job market demands was suggested.
 - Following Certificate courses were introduced:
 - Certificate course in English Speaking(BCOM)
 - Certificate course in Basic Computer (BCOM)
 - Certificate course in Script writing (BAMMC)
